The regular meeting of Austinburg Township held November 2, 2015 was called to order at 7:30pm with the pledge. Trustees Burke, Kusar, Dutton, Ted, Ginny Seifert, Laura Mullins, Lindsay Mullins, Michael, Alice Orth, Bill Thomas, Erika, Jim Heath, and Phil Miller were present.

Res 127-15 John moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as written. Jerry seconded. The roll call vote; Dutton, aye. Burke, aye. Kusar, aye.

Res. 128-15 John moved to pay the bills of the township. Byron seconded. The roll; Kusar, aye. Burke, aye. Dutton, aye.

Receipts were \$47,103.53. Bill totaled \$70,709.03.

Bill Thomas sent a letter of resignation from his position of Zoning Commission Chairman.

John K. said there is no price on salt from Morbito yet.

John reported township newsletters have been mailed out.

Jerry said he will check on some other salt vendors.

Jerry asked John about his neighbor with a drainage problem. Jerry said he will ask the County to stake the area so she can view the area.

Jerry inquired if we have received an agreement for an easement from Koski yet; Byron stated he has left messages with them for an agreement but will send a certified letter to Donald Koski requesting the easement agreement.

Jerry said the OPWC grant application is complete and sent in. Discussion was held on the town hall steps and office ceiling tiles. Both need repair.

Byron reported the NAD meeting will be Tuesday, November 3 at 6:00pm.

Byron presented three copies of signed agreements with Bill and Sheila Arth for the removal of their pond hydrant. The agreement was drawn up by the County Prosecutor. One will be kept in township files, one given to the Arths, and one sent to the Prosecutor.

Ted Seifert stated he called the Sheriff Dept. regarding people in Center Cemetery one night. It turned out to be a scavenger hunt, and the participants were told they could not be in the cemetery.

Alice Orth commented that the Austin Cemetery sign mounted on the fence either needs repaired or should be removed.

Jim and Erika Heath both commented on their concerns about the ongoing discussions taking place over College St. and the GRA's requests for added safety measures. There has been mention of installing a cross street at the end of College near Rt. 307 and the elimination of the current Rt. 307/College St. Intersection. Jim said this will route traffic to exit right across from his driveway. There is a bend there with high traffic speeds and he believes this will cause even more safety hazards and wrecks. The Heaths feel GRA would be taking a dedicated road and doing whatever they want with it. Mr. Heath also said he would like the speed bumps on College St. removed.

The trustees explained the township is just gathering information at this point regarding the cross street and would need ODOT to approve this first. They will have to wait to see what ODOT might suggest. The board also stated legislators are looking into traffic regulations for a boarding school and the hours they maintain.

Res. 129-15 Byron moved to adjourn the meeting. Jerry seconded. The meeting adjourned at 8:45pm.
