Bills paid were \$17,366.83 and Receipts were \$20,401.58.


We received notice that the Public Hearing on the map change will be Nov. 2 at 6:00pm at the Townhall. We also received notice that as of Oct. 23, 2020 the Ashtabula County Planning Commission voted to recommend for approval of Case 2020-014 Austinburg Township Map Amendment. The paperwork for the OPWC grant for the piping and road work on Forman Road has been turned in for review. The Ashtabula Health Dept. sent an email reporting as of 10/27/20 that there have 784 confirmed cases and 48 deaths in Ashtabula County from the COVID 19 virus.

Zoning Administrator Rob Lupah reported on the map change hearing. Zoning is still working on ordering a lap tap for the Zoning Administrator.

Jerry reported that the paperwork for the OPWC grant was turned in on the basic improvements for Forman Road. Need to verify through OPWC that we have been approved for the grant for 2nd phase of Forman Road the paving. Bryon reported the Trustees needs to call for a Public Hearing on the map change. The Public Hearing will be Nov. 16th at 7:00 pm at the Townhall. There is a NAD meeting Nov. 4. There will be a Zoning Board meeting Wed. Nov. 4 at 5:15 pm. John spoke with the Ashtabula County Engineers office in regards to the need for a turnaround at the end of GH Drive. John is going to send a letter to the owners of the land near the proposed turnaround to see what the possibilities would be of acquiring some of the land needed to put in the turnaround. John spoke with Sidley's in regards to the road that was cut to put in lines for the new Sidley building. The construction company for the new Sidley building said they will repair the road. The furnace in the Fire Station is in and working. The cost of the furnace will be practically paid through the NOPEC grant. Byron said we need to replace the 2 outside lights on the Townhall. John said to contact Dan Gildersleeve and have him put in the lights and also check the wiring at the same time.

The meeting was opened to the residents but nothing was discussed.
