We received an email from ODNR that the Paddling Enhancement Grant has been reestablished if we would like to apply for it. The ODNR feels this would be used for the Tote Road boat launch. The Ashtabula Health Dept. sent an email reporting as of 12/02/20 that there have been 2,850 confirmed cases and 59 deaths in Ashtabula County from the COVID 19 virus.


Rob Lupah, Zoning Administrator reported on permits he had issued. The one was for a variance for the building on the corner of route 45 and 307 North East corner
