The regular meeting of the Austinburg Township Board of Trustees opened at 7:30 pm. In attendance were Rob Lupah, Bill Wilms and Mike Kovacic.

Res. 34-21 John moved to accept the minutes as written, Jerry seconded. The roll; Burke, aye. Dutton, aye. Kusar aye.

Res. 35-21 John moved to pay the bills, Jerry seconded. The roll; Burke, aye. Dutton, aye. Kusar, aye. Bills paid were \$21,933.62 and receipts were \$25,954.25.

We received an email from the Ashtabula Health Dept. in regards to the COVID update. As of Feb. 23 2021 there are 5,921 confirmed case and 147 deaths in Ashtabula County.

The Fiscal Officer reported that we will be getting audited by the State Auditor Office starting March 3, 2021. The tentative cost will be \$2,747. The Fiscal Officer reported a correction to the final appropriations for 2021. The amount is \$1,655,047.65 which is \$100.00 less than first reported.

Bill Wilms, Fire Chief reported that he will get the MARCS radios ordered.

Rob Lupah, Zoning Administrator reported he had issued a few permits.

Jerry reported that he will be getting prints for the new roof of the old Township garage. There is no 3 phase electric going to the old Township garage anymore. Jerry reported he had concerns over the recycling bins looking like a garage disposal however that is a County issue. Byron reported on NAD meeting and Zoning meeting coming up this week. Byron will be attending the County Waterline board meeting March 21st in Jefferson. John talked to Mike Petro about his needs for stone bids.


